Regarding the Purchase of Chometz after Pesach 5780 | 2020

GROCERY STORES

Based on our research Chometz from all Major Grocery Stores is permitted to be purchased at this time. Almost all stores in our area have no Jewish ownership, and the ones that have Jewish Ownership have divested themselves from owning Chometz for the duration of Pesach according to Torah Law. For those that prefer not to rely on any sale of Chometz the following are the best options:

All KVH Kosher Certified Establishments have divested themselves from owning Chometz for the duration of Pesach according to Torah Law.

Please note: The grocery store in Ulin House 30 Wallingford Rd, Brighton, MA 02135, is Jewish owned and, according to our research has NOT sold the chometz belonging to the store.

LIQUOR STORES

Liquor Stores continue to present a serious concern in light of Jewish ownership of many local Liquor stores, as well as major Liquor Distributors in the Greater Boston Area. Therefore, until the end of June 2020 KVH Kosher recommends Chometz beverages purchased in one of the above locations, any non-Jewish-Owned Liquor Store, or one of the following liqueur stores should be purchased.
