

# cRc 2010 Passover Supervised Products



**A** *note of caution:* Labels bearing the inscription “**Kosher For Passover**” can be produced by any printer. The presence of such a label does not guarantee that the product to which it is affixed is therefore truly Kosher for Passover. For a

product to be considered Kosher for Passover, it must bear the endorsement of an authoritative Orthodox Rabbi or Rabbinic group. This especially applies to companies producing meat products for Passover use. Since we update our information as

close to Passover as possible, information included here is accurate as of the date of publication. Please feel free to check [www.crcweb.org](http://www.crcweb.org) or contact the cRc office closer to Passover, since changes may have taken place after publication of this guide.

## **Milk and Other Dairy Products**

These products cannot be packed for Passover after March 29 due to the fact that dairies cannot be monitored after that date. The “freshness date” of fluid milk is for 14 days after packaging in Chicago and suburbs; cottage cheese and sour cream have dates up to 30 days. Therefore, it is recommended that milk and milk

products sufficient for the full 8 days of Passover should be purchased **before the holiday**, as stores may not have P-10 (meaning Passover 2010) on the label or container during the holiday itself. Only those dairy products stamped “P-10” or bearing “Kosher for Passover” have been produced under our special supervision for the 2010 Passover holiday. The cRc does not super-

vised any chocolate milk, yogurt, or cottage cheese for Passover. Since dairies produce products on a wide variety of labels, we are listing names of actual plants together with their plant numbers. Also shown are some major brand names in the Chicago area. **The following brands may be used for Passover if bearing one of the Plant Numbers shown plus the P-10:**

## **Coffee**

Folgers and Tasters Choice Instant Coffee – unflavored, regular – are acceptable without special certification for Passover; this does not include decaf

The following coffees are kosher for Passover only when bearing the kosher symbol and the letter P: Maxim, Maxwell House, Sanka and Yuban

Whole Bean and Fresh Ground Bean: Unflavored plain ground or whole bean coffees do not need special certification for Passover; this does not include decaf

Decaf requires Passover certification.

ALL instant coffee must bear Passover certification.
