Purchasing *Chometz* After Pesach

If *chometz* has been in a Jew's possession over Pesach, it is subsequently forbidden for consumption.

1. Please note that any entity certified kosher by Scroll K is assured to be free of this concern.
2. When purchasing *chometz* from a third party vendor, it may be problematic even if it was produced by one of the manufacturing facilities listed below. If the vendor is Jewish-owned and was in possession of the item over Pesach it would be forbidden.
